People in Shanghai have the pleasure of experiencing weightlessness this week as Argentinian artist Leandro Erlich brought his wildly popular [project of grand illusion](#) to the Jing'an Kerry Center in downtown Shanghai.

This project features a huge mirror staged at a 45-degree angle to reflect people on the ground. The horizontal print has been made so to resemble the facade of shikumen house, a traditional Shanghainese architectural style fusing Western and Chinese elements. As a result, a visual illusion is created as if the viewers are performing gravity-defying stunts.

The project is open to the Chinese public until this Friday.
